Gift Cards for Fire Victims Needed: A staff member with Legal Aid of North Louisiana (a division of Acadiana Legal Service Corp.) suffered a devastating loss on July 24, 2017 as the result of a fire at her apartment complex in Monroe. The fire was in the apartment directly above the unit occupied by the staff member and her daughter. The ceiling of the staff member's unit collapsed resulting in most of her personal property being severely damaged or destroyed as the result of smoke and water.
