#### Registration Instructions:

- 1. Complimentary membership in the BRBA is offered to attorneys in their first year of practice. To join the BRBA, please complete the membership form included in this packet.
- On Dec. 12, 2017, attorneys have the opportunity to be admitted to the Eastern, Western and Middle Districts of Louisiana and the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit. Each court requires a separate application and a separate check (no cash, please) made payable to the appropriate court.
- 3. The Eastern, Western and Middle Districts and the Fifth Circuit do not require Certificates of Good Standing for attorneys admitted in Louisiana in October 2017.
- 4. An ORIGINAL Certificate of Good Standing is required for each court to which you are applying if you were admitted PRIOR to JUNE 1, 2017.
- 5. In order to obtain your Certificates of Good Standing, you must call the Louisiana Supreme Court at (504) 310-2315. You will be asked to leave a message with your name, bar roll number, phone number and the number of certificates you need. You can either have the certificates mailed to you or can pick them up at the Court. You should call as soon as possible as it may take the Court up to five days to process your request. There is a \$20 fee for each certificate requested. Certificates mailed to you must be paid for in advance. Certificates picked up at the court must be paid for upon receipt. Checks should be made out to: Clerk of Courts Office, Louisiana Supreme Court. Checks should be mailed to Clerk of Courts Office, Louisiana Supreme Court, 400 Royal St. Ste. 4200, New Orleans, LA 70130.

Alternatively, you may contact Louisiana State Bar Association Member Records Assistant, Sharon L. Lessing, at (504) 619-0101 or <a href="mailto:sharon.lessing@lsba.org">sharon.lessing@lsba.org</a> for a certificate of good standing.

- 6. The Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals requires registration for a CM/ECF Filing Account with the Fifth Circuit to complete your admissions process. Please register for an account **prior** to turning in your admission paperwork to ensure timely processing of your admission. - 7. All completed applications, Certificates of Good Standing and the appropriate fee for each court to which you are seeking admission must be **RECEIVED** by Ann K. Gregorie at the BRBA by **NOVEMBER 13, 2017**. The mailing address for the BRBA is P.O. Box 2241, Baton Rouge, LA 70821. The physical address is 544 Main Street, Baton Rouge, LA 70801.

#### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

**Do I have to turn in a separate petition for each court?** Yes, each court requires an originally signed petition.

**Do I have to type the petitions?** This requirement has been waived for this program. Petitions do not have to be typed, but they have to be printed legibly in blue or black ink.

Which forms must I submit for the Eastern District? Besides the petition for admission, the Eastern District requires that you complete the Attorney Registration Statement and the Electronic Case Filing System Attorney Registration Form.

Which forms must I submit for the Western District? Besides the petition for admission, the Western District requires that you complete the Written Oath for Admission to Practice. If you are NOT a newly admitted Louisiana attorney, you must also submit a Certificate of Good Standing. You must do this only IF you were admitted to practice more than 60 days before June 1, 2017.

Which forms must I submit for the Middle District? The Middle District is no longer accepting hard copies of petitions, but requires that applications for admission to practice be completed on line. The registration link is:

By selecting Baton Rouge on the drop down bar for the mass swearing in ceremony site, you will direct them to send your certificate to the BRBA for distribution at our program.

#### Applying for Admission with the Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals

Applications for the Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals are submitted and paid through the Court's CM/ECF system. Please register for a **Pacer CM/ECF APPELLATE FILER Account** with the Fifth Circuit to begin your admissions process. Please indicate you are an ATTORNEY, NOT ADMITTED TO PRACTICE in the Fifth Circuit on the registration form.

Registration tips:

- Passwords must be 8 14 characters and contain at least 2 nonalphacharacters; you can enter a password of your choosing or allow the system to generate one for you
- Please note that the form is for ALL appellate courts and you must check off the box for the Fifth Circuit

Once registered, and after you receive you bar roll number, you are ready to complete your application. The application is attached, please fill out the application and sign it in front of a Notary. You must also have a Movant (an attorney who is a current member of the Fifth Circuit) sign your application -if you do not know a current member to sign your form, you may write a letter asking for the Clerk of Court to sponsor your membership (upload this letter with your application). After your application is complete, scan it and save it as a PDF file on the computer you will use to complete your registration process.

Attorneys newly admitted to the state bar (within 30 days) DO NOT need to supply a Certificate of Good Standing.

Once your Application is prepared and scanned and you are ready to upload your application and pay the required fee of \$231.00 (both credit card or checks are paid on-line).


#### Submitting an Attorney Bar Application Electronically to the Fifth Circuit:

Note: Non-bar members must register to become an ECF filing user in order to submit a bar application for admission electronically. Limited access privileges will be approved until admitted to the Fifth Circuit's bar, at which time full electronic filing access will be authorized.

Applications for Admission must be submitted by the registered ECF filer attorney only. Attorneys may not submit applications on behalf of other attorneys.


